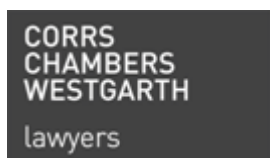


In recent months, the NSW Law Reform Commission and Australian Law Reform Commission have been completing major inquiries into privacy law.
